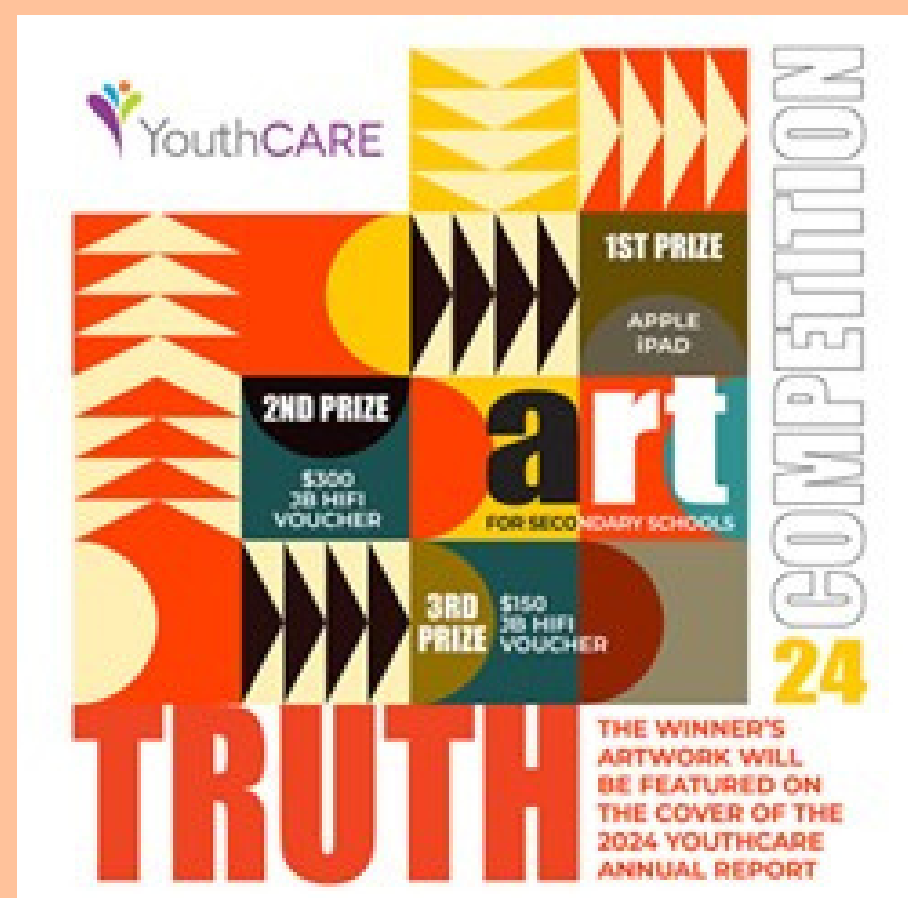

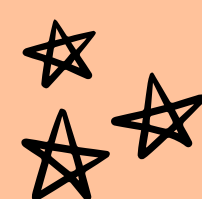


## Things to do in the Holidays

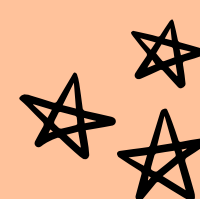


